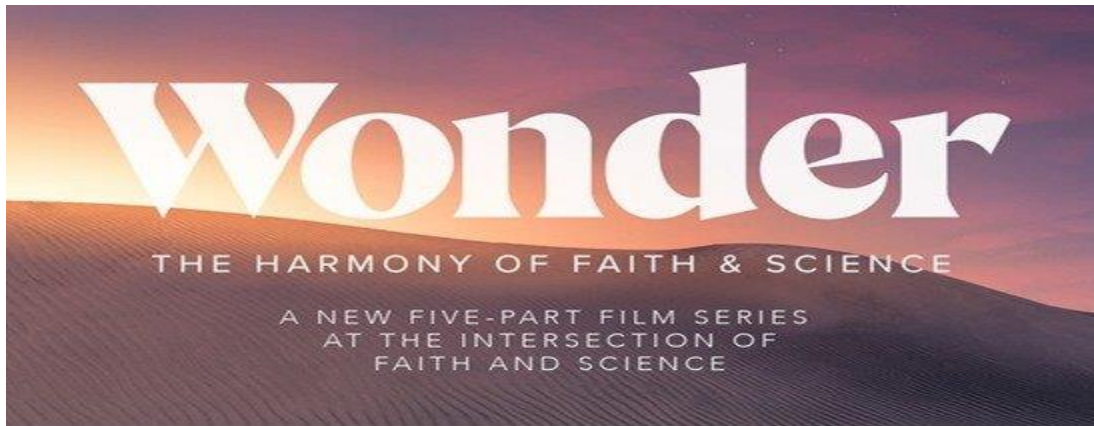
Dr. Joan Kelly will conclude our Parish Mission with her presentation of:

“Suffering and Death in the Christian Tradition”

Christ extended compassion to the sick and the dying and the Church has continued that ministry of Christ throughout its history. Our country's vast network of Catholic hospitals gives tremendous witness to this fact. The lives of many saints were profoundly impacted by an experience of suffering (e.g. Saint Ignatius of Loyola, Saint Francis of Assisi). During the Lenten season we ponder more deeply the Crucified Christ on the Cross realizing that as Christians our suffering endured in union with Christ is a participation in His saving mission.

Dr. Joan Kelly teaches in the Catholic Studies Department at Sacred Heart University in Fairfield. A graduate of Saint Joseph College in West Hartford, she received a Master's Degree in Theology from the Catholic University of America in Washington, D.C. and a Doctorate from the Graduate Theological Foundation at Notre Dame in Indiana.

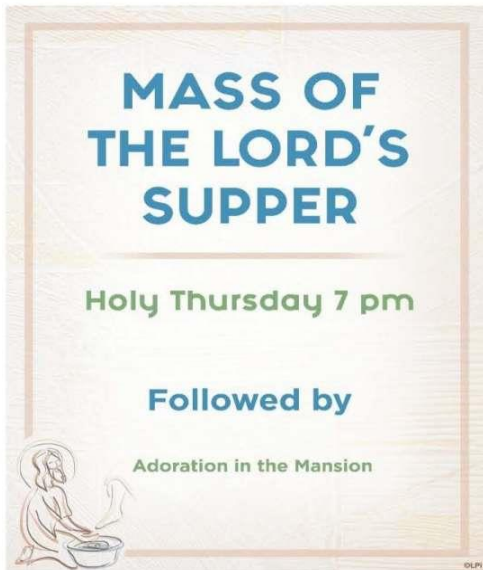

(No 7:30 am & No 12:15 pm Mass)

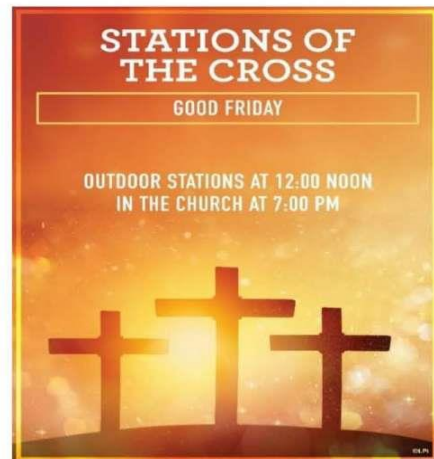
Commemoration of the Lord's Supper at 7:00 pm followed by Adoration with Closing Prayer at 11:30 pm in the Mansion. Various ethnic breads (must be store-bought) will be presented at the Offertory. Bring your bread to your pew and process down the center aisle as for Communion. If you are unable to attend, wrapped bread may be left in the main vestibule on Thursday. The Breads will be added to the Food Pantry Easter Baskets that will be given out on Good Friday.
