Pentecost, which translates to “the fiftieth”, is the Greek name for “Shavuot”, the Feast of Weeks, a prominent feast in the calendar of ancient Israel celebrating the giving of the Law of Moses at Sinai. Pentecost is celebrated fifty days after Easter Sunday, hence its name.

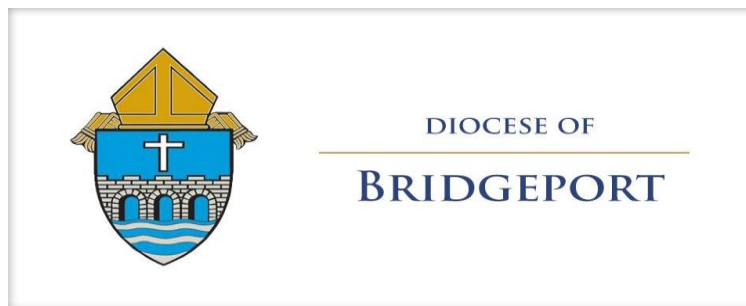

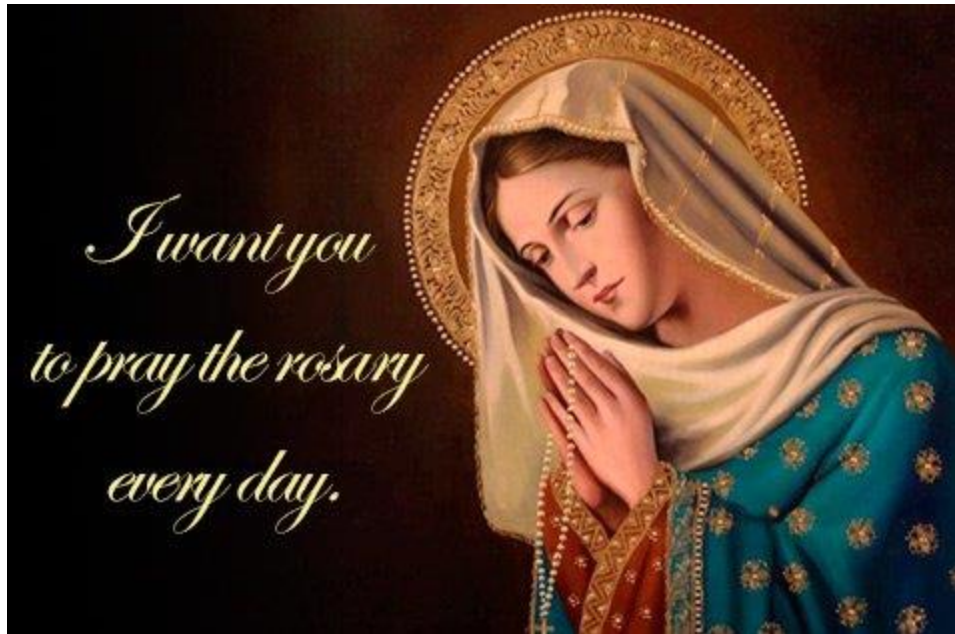
