Saturday, September 21, 2019 Scarecrow Contest Rules

- Eligibility: The St. Philip Family Fall Festival Scarecrow Contest is open to all ages, families and groups that would love to be creative and make a Scarecrow.
- Registration Form and Fee are due by September 15, 2019 and can be mailed or dropped off to the parish office.
- Registration Fee: \$10.00 for Families or Group
- All entries must be crafted by hand.
- All entries must be family friendly. Entries of gruesome, violent or offensive nature will not be allowed. Saint Philip Church reserves the right, and at the discretion of the Scarecrow Contest Judges to approve or refuse the contents. If the Judges determine that such exhibit, or any part thereof, is not in conformance with the Saint Philip Church or the Diocese of Bridgeport policies, that decision shall be final and binding on all parties hereto.
- Please include in the display an 8"x10" sign with your "Entry Name" and the Family or Group name. No signs or articles may be affixed, nailed or otherwise attached to walls, doors, etc. Likewise, no attachment may be made to the walkways by nails, screws, or any other device that would damage them.
- All scarecrows and props must fit into a 4'x6' area for display.
- Scarecrows can be assembled on Saturday, September 21, 2019 as early as 7:00 am and must be completed by 9:00 am.
- Scarecrows must be able to stand on their own from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm using your own props.
- No supplies, assistance or electricity will be provided by St. Philip Church. No flammable objects are allowed. Extremely loud noises, such as sirens, bells, horns, etc., will not be permitted.
- Winners will be announced by 11:00 am. and prizes awarded. Winners need not be present.
- Scarecrows must be on display during Family Fall Festival and may be picked up between 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Saturday, September 21, 2019. St. Philip Church is not responsible for loss or damages of abandoned Scarecrows. Entries that are not picked up become the property of St. Philip Church.
- St. Philip Church is not responsible for injuries or for damage to Scarecrow entries at any point of event participation.
- St. Philip Church may use photos of your entry or you with your entry at any time in the future (print or electronic) in either church publications and or in its advertising.
